

Electronics Technicians.

The job involves fabrication and testing of temperature cable assemblies, following blue prints and specifications using measuring instruments, hand tools, and machines.

Duties include:

- Reading and interpreting blueprints, work orders, and specifications to determine sequence of operations, type and size of cable and fittings required, quantity, and finished dimensions.
- Measuring and cutting cables to required lengths, considering cable stretch and metal flow resulting from swaging operations, using cable cutter or saw.
- Assembling fittings onto cable in specified location
- Verifying dimensions of cable assembly and position of fittings, using measuring instruments.
- Potentially operating crimping tool; marking identification information on cable assemblies.

Ideal candidates will be familiar with OHM meters, basic electronics and conduit installation. Candidates also need to be: detailed and quality oriented; respectful of safety; good team players; willing to travel (estimated to be 25 nights a year) and to perform work at high altitudes; be able to distinguish colors; able to drive a fork lift; and able to communicate well with end customers. A valid driver's license is also required and applicants must be insurable.
